

## Inattentive and Careless Responding Inventory for Adjectives

### *Directions*

Please indicate your level of agreement with each of the statements below using the following rating scale.

- 6 = Strongly agree
- 5 = Moderately agree
- 4 = Slightly agree
- 3 = Slightly disagree
- 2 = Moderately disagree
- 1 = Strongly disagree

1. I am **asleep**, not awake.
2. I am **mortal**, able to die. (R)
3. I am perfectly **triangular**.
4. I am **human**. (R)
5. I tend to be **carbonated**.
6. I am **literate**, able to read and write. (R)

### *Scoring Directions*

Only the bolded adjectives should be administered with adjective-based scales (e.g., the Big Five Mini-Markers; Saucier, 1994). The full ICRIA statements should be administered with adjective-derived scales (e.g., the Big Five Inventory – 2; Soto & John, 2017). To create an index of careless and insufficient effort responding, the participants' responses to all of the items should be averaged together. Adjectives followed by (R) should be reverse-coded (e.g., 1 becomes 6) prior to averaging.
